Habitat for Humanity-La Crosse Area and the Habitat ReStore are committed to green practices. The ReStore is an outlet store for new and recycled building materials, which keeps usable products out of the landfills. More than 580 tons have been diverted from the landfill since the ReStore's opening in 2006. We also strive for green construction by building to Energy Star standards. Our 30th home at 910 Hope Court received a five-star-plus rating, the highest attainable, and ranked in the top 5% of Energy Star tested homes in Wisconsin and the top 1% of all homes built in the state. In addition to providing safe, decent, and affordable homes to families in need, Habitat for Humanity-La Crosse Area partners with families by being conscientious builders. An energy efficient home can save our homeowners 30% on their utility bills. The areas of Energy Star certification – air-tightness, ventilation and efficiency – are of high importance when we build homes. It is great knowing our homes are safe, comfortable, durable, and energy efficient for our families.
